C.S. Davidson, Inc.

Consider Approval of Change Order #1 to the 2012 Street Projects

Engineer Ben Baltzer requested that Council approve Change Order #1 to the 2012 Street Projects in the amount of \$15,998.00 to mill and overlay the office parking lot. This would bring the total cost of the 2012 street project to \$95,205.56. Michael H. Altland made a motion, seconded by Kyle E. Heidlebaugh, to approve Change Order #1. Motion Carried.

Solicitor's Report

Messersmith Property- 58 South East Street

Solicitor Jones reported to Council that he and Manager Shaffer contacted Springleaf Financial Services, the company that had foreclosed on the property located at 58 South East Street and previously owned by Barry Messersmith Sr. and advised them that the sewer bill for that property was delinquent. The Borough has received payment for that bill.

Michelle Prince Appeal

Solicitor Jones reported to Council that he notified the attorney representing Michelle Prince that the Borough needed to have a decision by the end of March whether she plans to move forward or withdraw the land use appeal. She now intends to withdraw the appeal.

Marcellus Shale Oil/Gas Act

Solicitor Jones reported to Council that legislators in Harrisburg have mandated that every municipality in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania allow specific types of drilling activities in their municipality related to the drilling and distribution of Marcellus Shale Gas, which means the Borough must amend it's Zoning and Subdivision Ordinances to allow for these specific uses. The Borough will not receive any money, as there are no active wells in York County and the county must have just one active well to be entitled to pass an impact fee. Additionally, municipalities have only six months to amend their zoning and subdivision ordinances. Solicitor Jones commented that it is possible that the PUC will issue a model ordinance for the Boroughs to adopt through PSATS or PSAB.
