

**SPRING GROVE BOROUGH
YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

RESOLUTION 6-2010

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PA DOT), has established a policy regarding the installation of signs and banners across State Highways and has required the Borough of Spring Grove (Municipality) to pass a resolution addressing the relevant issues relating to the Habitat For Humanity Fundraiser.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. The installation location shall be between Main Street, SR 0116, Segment 250, offset 0 and SR 0116, Segment 260, offset 0, which is the intersection with Hoke Street. The vertical clearance above the Roadway shall be 17 feet, 6 inches (minimum).
2. The size of the banner shall be 3 feet x 15 feet. The description shall read "Habitat For Humanity Fundraiser – Elicker's Grove – Food Music Games Prizes October 16th."
3. The banner shall be installed by the Comcast Cable Television Company and Spring Grove Borough Public Works employees on or about Septebmer 27, 2010 and removed by the Comcast Cable Television Company on or about October 18, 2010. The banner is to be installed on a one-time basis.
4. That the municipality assumes full responsibility for erecting, maintaining, and removing the device and all liability for damage occurring to any persons or property arising from any act or omission associated with the banner.
5. Acknowledgement that no more than 20% of the message will relate to naming or advertising commercial product, enterprise, business, or company regardless of whether they are sponsoring the event or banner installation.
6. That traffic control will be performed in accordance with the most current PA DOT Publication 203.
