A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE SUBMISSION OF A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT APPLICATION FOR WEST HIGHLAND AVENUE, WEST SPRING STREET, NORTH WALNUT STREET, WEST HOKE STREET, BAILEY AVENUE AND CHERRY AVENUE.

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Spring Grove deems it to be in the best interest of the Borough to submit Community Development Block Grant applications to the County of York; and,

WHEREAS, C.S. Davidson, Inc. (Borough Engineer) is hereby directed to prepare Community Development Block Grant applications for curb and sidewalk improvements along West Highland Avenue (from Chestnut Street to North Walnut Street), West Spring Street (from North Walnut to North High Street), North Walnut Street (from West Jackson to West Hoke Street), West Hoke Street (from North Walnut to Chestnut Street), Bailey Avenue (from the Southside of North High Street to Cherry Avenue), Cherry Avenue (from the Westside of Bailey Avenue to West Jackson Street)

WHEREAS, the Borough hereby authorizes the commitment of money from its General Fund as outlined in said grant applications; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough Council President and Borough Secretary are hereby authorized to sign each and any said grant application on behalf of the Borough.
